News from Tougo from January to May 2025

The dry season of 2025 was marked by intense activity carried out by different sections of the farm.

The following paragraphs present the actions carried out during this period, most of which part of which was devoted to development work in the NAMENGBE-ZANGA perimeter of RASKO.

At the land development unit, the actual development work on the NAMENGBE-ZANGA perimeter in Rasko began this year. With a total area of 132 hectares, the perimeter comprises 54 lots, including 8 communal lots. The perimeter, characterized by the presence of several hills, has been subdivided into seven blocks to facilitate payment. Work began with the marking out of internal trenches, followed by digging by contract teams on the HIMO site. The work is supervised by CAF technicians to ensure the proper construction of erosion control embankments. To date, more than 12,000 meters of embankments have been built and 50 infiltration ponds dug, for a cumulative volume of 3,000 m³ of earth moved.



The contractors who participated in the HIMO project have been paid.

For the period from January to May, a cumulative rainfall of 7 millimeters was recorded, spread over three rain events.

A test plot was set up this year at the pilot farm to facilitate activities in the new Rasko bocage area. Once the site was ready, we began digging zaï holes to prepare for the campaign.



At the nursery, seedling production activities have begun and are progressing very well. In total, more than 3,000 seedlings have been produced, including baobab, Cassia *sieberiana*, *Randga*, and *Albizia lebbek*, etc.
